Beethovenfest Bonn 2010 in brief

Structure

- Gemeinnützige GmbH (limited liability non-profit company);
Shareholders: City of Bonn (2/3) and Deutsche Welle (1/3)

Events

- 67 concerts at 25 venues from 10 September to 9 October 2010 (excluding the fringe programme)
- Opening with "Look at Beethoven" on 9 September 2010 in Kunstmuseum Bonn
- Extensive fringe programme (including symposium, exhibitions, lectures, readings, Post Tower Lounge concerts, workshops, films, installations)
Announcement of the fringe programme: July 2010
- New venues for 2010 are Kanzlerbungalow and Kammerspiele Bad Godesberg
- More than 2,500 artists will contribute to the Beethovenfest Bonn

Sales

- Available tickets: 42,000, start of advance sales: 17 April 2010
- Average ticket price: 40 euros
- Ticket prices vary from 9 to 95 euros (plus advance-sales fee)
- School and college students get a 50 % discount for all concerts
At selected concerts, the Beethovenfest Bonn reserves a certain number of seats for school and college students (below the age of 30). These cannot be booked in advance. At these concerts, a certain number of seats are reserved for students, tickets for which can be bought for 8 € on production of a valid student identity card.

Budget

The total budget of the Beethovenfest 2010: 4.5 million euros (2009: 4.6 million euros)

- 32% of the budget comes from public grants (the city of Bonn, the Rhein-Sieg district); project support from the state of North-Rhine Westphalia and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs
- The remaining funds are obtained by the company (sponsors, foundations, ticket sales, media fees)
